Linux on the commandline

Learn how to navigate confidently on the command line of a Linux system. Learn not only the individual commands, but also how to combine them in a meaningful way to achieve the desired result. Learn how to find files, search their contents, and output them.

In the second part of the seminar, you will get a first insight into shell scripts. You will learn the different ways to execute a shell script. This part gives you an insight into the possibilities of automating tasks using shell scripts.

You have already worked with Linux and had your first contact with the console and are now curious to learn more. No prior knowledge of shell programming is required.

A virtual machine with a distribution of your choice. Debian-based is preferred.
